In 1838 he moved to America and entered the General Theological Seminary in New York. He graduated in 1841 and was sent as a missionary to Wisconsin. His works include: Mercy to Babes: A Plea for the Christian Baptism of Infants (1847), The Elements of Christian Science (1850) and A New Treatise on Baptismal Regeneration (1871).
